NOTICE OF PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS AND PARALLEL CROSSING ON IXWORTH ROAD, THURSTON

Suffolk County Council proposes to construct two raised table road humps on Ixworth Road (C562), Thurston. The first raised table road hump will be at the uncontrolled pedestrian crossing point 90 metres north of new access and will measure 8.5 metres long and 5 metres wide. The second raised table will measure 42.4 metres long and 5 metres wide located outside of the new access.

The second raised table road hump will also incorporate a parallel crossing (zebra crossing with cycle facilities) and will assist pedestrians crossing Ixworth Road (C562) at a level surface with the footway. The centre line of the proposed parallel crossing is to be located approximately 65 metres north of its junction with Cedars Close.

A map showing the location of the raised table road hump and parallel crossing, and the Council's reasons for this proposal may be seen with advanced notice at **Thurston Library, Norton Road, Thurston, Bury St Edmunds, IP31 3PB**, Tuesday 14:00-18:00, Wednesday 10:00-13:00, Thursday 14:00-18:00, Friday 10:00-13:00, Saturday 10:00-15:00 and Sunday 10:00-15:00.
