No flash photography or additional lighting should be used without prior consent.

People who act improperly or in a disruptive manner may be excluded from the meeting.

Anyone wishing to report on the meeting should notify the Clerk or Chairman so that they can be afforded reasonable facilities.

People under the age of 18 or other members of the public not wishing to be filmed or photographed should notify the Clerk or Chair and should sit in the area designated for this purpose.
