

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (BURY ST EDMUNDS) (MORETON HALL) (VARIOUS
ROADS) (OVERNIGHT PROHIBITION OF ENTRY OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES
EXCEPT LOADING) ORDER 202-**

Suffolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (the Act of 1984) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:

PART 1: INTERPRETATION

1. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereto respectively assigned to them:

“heavy commercial vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act of 1984

2. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order are without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment

PART 2: OVERNIGHT PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle weighing 7.5 tonnes or above to enter any lengths of the road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order between the hours of 22:00 and 07:00 Monday – Sunday

PART 3: EXEMPTIONS

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a heavy commercial vehicle to enter or proceed in any of the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order if the vehicle is being used:
 - a) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to;
 - (i) the said lengths of road; or
 - (ii) any side road accessible only from the said lengths of road;
 - b) for the purposes of loading or unloading goods from the vehicle;
 - c) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to the said lengths of road or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - d) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to, the said lengths of road of any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;

- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to the said lengths of road, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (v) in the service of any Statutory undertaker, the Environment Agency or any public authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (vi) use for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- e) to proceed to or from any premises which are situated in or adjacent to the said lengths of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been, garaged, serviced or repaired;
- f) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- g) in connection with a circus, fair or similar event the holding of which on, or in the vicinity of, the said lengths of road has been authorised by the appropriate Council.

PART 4: CITATION

5. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Bury St Edmunds) (Moreton Hall) (Various Roads) (Overnight Prohibition of Entry of Heavy Commercial Vehicles Except Loading) Order 202- and shall come into operation on []

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes between the hours of 22:00 – 07:00, Monday – Sunday (Except for Loading)

Road	Description
Drovers Avenue (4U5937)	From the Bedingfeld Way/Skyliner Way roundabout to the junction with Coltsfoot Crescent (4U5934), a distance of approximately 60 metres.
Lady Miriam Way (U5930)	From the Skyliner Way/Rougham Tower Avenue roundabout in a northerly direction to the Mount Road roundabout (C692), a distance of approximately 750 metres.
Mount Road (C692)	From the junction with The Battlies (C769) in a westerly direction to the Orttewell Road roundabout (C766), a distance of approximately 2650 metres.
Orttewell Road (C766)	From the Bedingfeld Way/Skyliner Way roundabout to the junction with Barton Road (C765), a distance of approximately 1300 metres.
Primack Road (4U5931)	The full length from the junction with Skyliner Way (C769) to the junction with Lady Miriam Way (U5930), a distance of approximately 425 metres.
